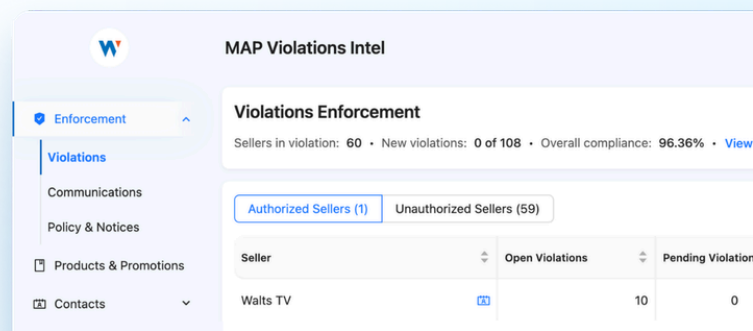
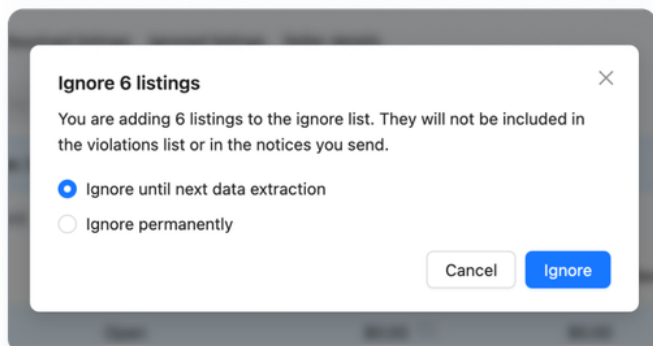
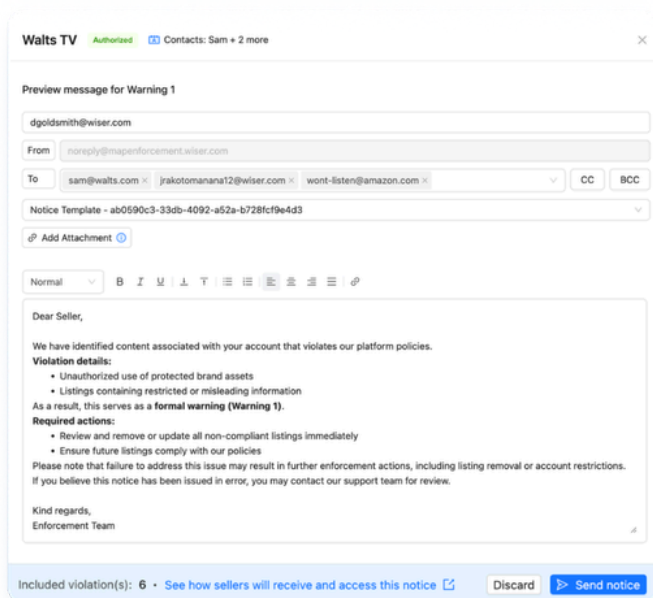
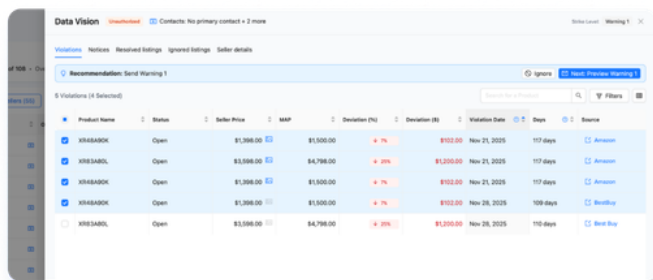
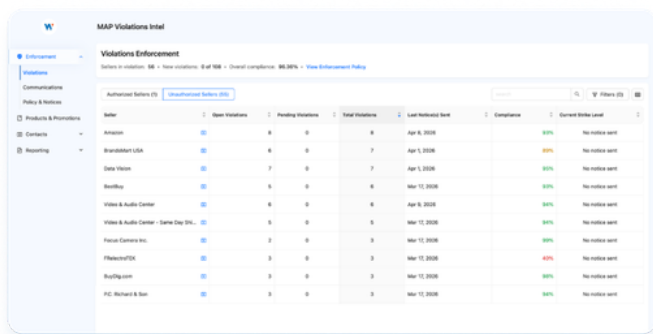
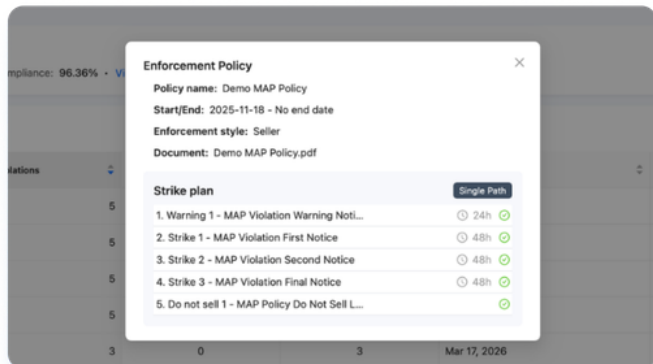


MAP Intelligence: Listing Enforcement



Listings Enforcement helps your team move from identifying violations to taking action with structured enforcement and seller notifications. Group violations, send templated notices, and track enforcement activity across sellers and listings.



1. Open Violations

- Open Enforcement from the left navigation
- Select Violations to view listings currently violating your MAP policy.

Tip: Policy configuration is managed in Policy & Notices, but enforcement actions are performed in the Violations section.

2. Review Violations

- The violations view displays listings currently violating your MAP policy.
- Each row includes details such as:
 - Seller price
 - MAP price
 - Deviation from MAP
 - Last detected date

3. Select Listings to Enforce

- Use the checkboxes on the left side of the table to select violations.
- You can select one listing or multiple listings at once.
- Multiple listings can be included in the same enforcement notice.

4. Choose an Action

The system recommends the next step based on your MAP policy.

Send Notice

- When sending a notice:
 - The correct policy step (warning or strike) is applied.
 - The configured email template is automatically populated.
 - You can review or edit before sending.
- After sending the notice:
 - The violation moves out of the Open tab.
 - The system begins the configured grace period.

Ignore Permanently

- The listing moves to **Ignored**.
- If the violation is still detected in a future crawl, it will return to **Open**.

Ignore Temporarily

- The listing will remain **Ignored**.
- It will not reappear unless you manually remove the ignore status.
